Thank you for showing interest in PhD studies at the Hebrew University of Jerusalem. You may find detailed information on our site (<http://www.research-students.huji.ac.il/en>) regarding the terms of acceptance, application procedures and forms; information about command of languages, including English and Hebrew; about deadlines, tuition, health insurance etc.. Please also pay attention to the Regulations of the Authority for Research Students.

Please note that you have to establish a connection with a potential advisor in order to apply. A letter of commitment from a would-be advisor is a crucial pre-requisite for further processing your request. On the site of the Hebrew University (<http://new.huji.ac.il/en>), you will find useful information about the academic units and the academic staff of the Hebrew University and their fields of research. In order to locate a suitable supervisor you may also look through published papers or write to the Chair of the department for advice.

Your Master's studies have to include a Research Thesis since this is a compulsory condition for acceptance. Your records of studies and diplomas will be evaluated by our experts shortly after you send all the documents.

In order to begin an application procedure please use the on-line registration system - <http://www.research-students.huji.ac.il/en/line-registration> .

A Doctorate Committee is in charge of screening candidates for Ph.D. studies. This Committee will discuss your application after your application file is completed and your previous studies are evaluated as described above.

Eventually, if accepted for PhD studies, you will have to present original official documents of your identification document, your diplomas and your records of studies.
